Dee Silverthorn is Distinguished Teaching Professor of Physiology at the new Dell Medical School at the University of Texas-Austin, where she is co-director of a course titled “Structure and Function.” The course integrates anatomy, physiology, histology, and radiology using modified case-based learning, interactive large group sessions in place of lectures, and weekly laboratory practicals. Prof. Silverthorn teaches physiology in all of these settings, as well as mentoring graduate students on developing teaching skills. Prior to moving to the medical school she taught undergraduate physiology to health professions students for more than 30 years. She has received numerous teaching awards and honors, including a University of Texas Regents’ Outstanding Teaching Award and the American Physiological Society's Arthur C. Guyton Physiology Educator of the Year. Her textbook, *Human Physiology: An Integrated Approach*, is currently in its eighth edition. Dee is an active member of the American Physiological Society and a past-president of the Human Anatomy & Physiology Society.
